1 Complete the Challenge.

Build an amazing Rube Goldberg Machine: an unnecessarily complex creation designed to perform a very simple task, usually involving lots of chain reactions.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Accomplish any simple task you want. Examples include: closing a book, tipping over a cup or ringing a bell. ✓ Use anything you want to build your machine. ✓ Make your machine as long or as complicated as you wish. Just be sure to film all of the action from start to finish! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Use a pre-made domino track. ✗ Interfere with the machine if something doesn't work. ✗ Give up when your machine doesn't work the first time.

 Our tips to avoid angry parents 	
DON'T	DO:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Use someone else's things without asking.  Leave machine parts all over the stairs or anywhere else.  Build your machine at the table right before lunch. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Clean up after yourself.  Ask permission to build your machine where you want to.  Agree on materials to use before you start building.

2 Create a video of your Rube Goldberg Machine.

Try to keep your video under 1-minute long and include the following:

- The name of your solution.
- How does it work?
- What kind of materials did you use?
- Did you have any problems figuring out the solution?
- What was the biggest lesson you learned?
